### 2. Our upcoming events:

The members of PPG UK Reading shared their view and interest in the possible virtual event. They are:

- **Webinar about finance and will** – on-going suggestion by Yadav Shrestha. It was highlighted in the meeting about the importance and planning of this webinar.
- **Webinar about Newah history, cultural origin** – suggested by Dr Santosh Pradhan. This webinar will aim to aware Newah people of their history, culture and tradition. For instance, Dibya Maharjan can talk about major festival and tradition of the Bhaktapur area.
